

While Armand worked with the **Mambo Kings** he gave an interview to **GQ Magasin**, it's written by **Stephanie Mansfield december 1991**.

While Armand drives the interviewer to an nearby Inn to have lunch (his wife, with kids are at the moment in Florida) he says:

"I would'nt want to live with me. **Because living with me in some ways, is living without me.** My wife has anextraordinary patience, and if she touned araound and left me today, I would'nt be surpriced."

He blames it the "degree of selfishness" it takes to be an actor. "You have to be willing to become a victim of circumstances, in your work and out of your work. That's the most frightening thing about being an actor. You have to be willing to allways be vulnerable to that situation, and if you're not, you are not alive. There are days when the entire production is one the path of one true feeling . It's all about you, and if these 50 people don't want you to be there, you've got to be here because this fucking camera is here. I've been in that situation, and it's the loneliest feeling on earth. If you've got a director who does'nt want to be there that night, then you gotta come up with the juice. That's a lonely feeling. Then you go back and try to live with another human being after you've done that ?. You gonna go back and try tell them, what you just went through ?

Are you kidding ? It can be living hell at times !

Only 3 years laiter Armands intuitive feeling, came true.
